

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Teams must complete the conditions entry sheet to register into a Soccer League.
2. Upon registration to a Soccer League all teams will be affiliated to The F.A. If team(s) decides to leave immediately after registration (even without playing a match) team(s) will be charged full admin fee and full F.A affiliation cost.
3. Teams must pay a £20 deposit before the first week of joining a Soccer League.
4. It is the responsibility of the team captain/manager to ensure all club players are aware of all rules associated with the league.
5. All Soccer League's are run under the jurisdiction of the F.A. players should be aware that cautionable offences may result in fines and bans from any F.A. competition and Soccer League UK competition.
6. Team(s) must check the website www.soccerleagueuk.com on the day as well before arriving to check any late changes on the fixtures and kick-off times; this is due to teams making late cancelations etc. It is the responsibility of team(s) manager, captain, vice-captain or the next in-charge person.
7. Teams must give 7 days' notice to cancel any fixtures. In extreme cases we may accept 48 hours notice as long as we can get a game for the opposition. Any cancelations on the day will be charged full match fee providing we can organise a league/cup match for the opposition. However, if we can't organise a league/cup match for the team they will be charged double match fee. We do our best to get teams to play and pay for two matches; if this is the case we won't charge any match fee. Please be reasonable when asked to play two matches by Soccer League organiser as this will help oppositions and your team.
8. Team(s) must not spam any Soccer League UK social networking services, any abuse/damage to Soccer League UK's services will be reported to social networks and immediate action will be taking by authorities.
9. Teams that do not turn up to matches will be charged full match fee's including oppositions match fees. Oppositions will be awarded with 3 points.
10. In the unlikely event your opposition doesn't turn up on match night we will always try to arrange a league/cup/friendly match. Team will receive 3 points but will still have to pay full match fee.
11. If team(s) decides to drop out of league then they must let Soccer League UK know with a minimum of 4 weeks' notice. All debts must be cleared and free-kits returned back in full (before 4 weeks' notice) – teams failing to return kits in full will be charged per shirt for any damaged/irreplaceable shirts.
12. If teams drops out without notifying Soccer League UK (without 4 weeks' notice) then they will be charged full match fees for four weeks plus oppositions match fees.
13. A minimum of 4 players MUST be on the pitch for game to be eligible.
14. It is essential to arrive 10-15 minutes prior to kick-off to get ready so games can be started on time. This is not the referee's call but due to booking demands. If team doesn't arrive on time, the clock will start on scheduled time.

15. Team(s) arriving late every 5 minutes will concede 1 goal. Team failing to arrive by 10 minutes will concede 2 goals and WIN shall be awarded to the opposition with a final 3rd goal and 3 points.
16. If team arrives more than 10 minutes late without notifying SOCCER LEAGUE UK then the match will be played as a friendly and opposition will receive 3 points and 3 goals. Full match fee will still have to be paid by BOTH teams.
17. Match fees MUST be paid in advance before team plays. – Teams have been known to pay later and then run away without paying. Team(s) will be penalised for following week due to late payment and reported to Soccer League UK's credit control department.
18. If teams are overdue by £20 for more than two weeks then the team will be fined £5 per week until the balance is cleared.
19. Should an appointed F.A. referee fail to appear for a fixture then Soccer League UK will arrange for a suitable replacement to officiate the match at short notice. In extreme cases if we fail to do this then teams are expected to have a representative from both teams to referee the match each half. Teams will play a friendly match instead and only pay half price. If teams have an outstanding balance then they will have to pay full match fee.
20. Warming up before game is to be done outside of the pitches, anyone warned verbally by SOCCER LEAGUE UK match coordinators will be penalised. (Several complaints have been logged from all teams that players/footballs are going on to pitches during games. Please consider your fellow team mates as you do not wish this to happen to your own team).
21. At half time, teams must change sides promptly to stop delay. A maximum of 1 minute to change over sides, clock will resume after 1 minute. Teams can stay on same sides for full match only if BOTH teams agree.
22. All teams must wear FA registered outfits: Shirt, shorts/joggers, socks, shin-pads and appropriate shoes for centre. (Please note that different venues have different rules. Please check with SOCCER LEAGUE UK'S match coordinators or the CENTRE/VENUE management. Anyone guilty playing with inappropriate footwear will be penalised by Soccer League UK or CENTRE/VENUE management).
23. No shin-pads, no game! Shin-pad is a mandatory FA requirement. If entire team does not wear shin-pad then opposing team will get 3 points and that match will be played as a friendly without a referee and charged full match fee. If both teams do not wear shin-pads then no points will be given, friendly match will be played without referee and teams will be charged as normal.
24. Referees' decisions are final and no arguments – players will be penalised if things go out of hand and will be reported to FA for further action (this will also affect 11-A-Side football).
25. Team(s) must make sure that their player(s)/supporter(s)/spectator(s) MUST NOT enter the play field at all conditions and DO NOT use abusive language. If teams are found guilty of not taking responsibility then action will be taking by SOCCER LEAGUE UK to the team(s) and team(s) fan/spectators will be asked to leave the ground. Further action may be taking by CENTRE/VENUE'S discretion.
26. All spectators MUST stay behind railings and on concrete.
27. Players/spectators MUST NOT stand near goal lines during matches.
28. Teams MUST walk around the side of the pitch and not across the middle whilst game is being played.

29. NO smoking, bikes and litter inside the CENTRE/VENUE pitch. Anyone found guilty will be penalised by SOCCER LEAGUE UK or CENTRE/VENUE management.
30. Once game has finished all teams MUST leave the pitch promptly, failure to do so will be resulted with a penalty at CENTRE/VENUE'S discretion.
31. In order to receive £100 the champions must carry on following season. This only applies to all Soccer League's except Inner-London in which the champions will receive £500 if team carries on following season.
32. ANY violent/indecent conduct from player(s)/team(s) toward match officials, Soccer League UK officials, teams or players, they will be indefinitely banned from SOCCER LEAGUE UK with a £40 fine (payment must be made within 7 day) and reported to The FA for further action. (This will affect 11-A-Side football and further action may be taken by CENTRE/VENUE's discretion). Further action will be taken by authorities.
33. If the team(s) is involved then Soccer League UK will indefinitely ban the team, they will be liable for the match fees for the remainder of the season. This will also be reported to the F.A and reported to local authorities.
34. 2 x Yellow/Blue card fines = £5. 1x Red card fines £10 + 1 match ban. ALL payments must be paid within 7 days to SOCCER LEAGUE UK to avoid further action by SOCCER LEAGUE UK and The FA.
